

# Château l'Argentier

Famille Jourdan, vignerons à Sommières depuis 1937







### Estate

Located in Sommières, between Nîmes and Montpellier, Château l'Argentier is run by the Jourdan family since 1937. Taking care of 24 hectares under vines, including 2,20 hectares classified under the Languedoc denomination « Sommières » and 5,94 hectares classified under the Languedoc denomination « Grès de Montpellier », current owners Élisabeth & François JOURDAN are committed to produce terroir-driven wines from Languedoc indigenous grapes such as Cinsault, Carignan, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah & Aramon. Produced from old vines planted on flinty soils, all the wines are fermented in concrete vats. After ageing in bottles, Château l'Argentier wines are released when they are at their best for drinking.

#### Wines

#### Château l'Argentier AOP Languedoc « Sommières » red

Produced from our **2,20 hectares** (4.41 acres) vineyard classified under the AOP Languedoc denomination « **Sommières** », this **Syrah-driven** wine is complex and well structured.

#### Château l'Argentier AOP Languedoc « Grès de Montpellier » red

Produced from our **5,94 hectares** (14.29 acres) vineyard classified under the AOP Languedoc denomination **« Grès de Montpellier »**, this **Grenache-driven** wine is complex and well balanced.

# Château l'Argentier « AOP Languedoc » red

Produced from **Syrah**, **Grenache** and **Carignan**, this **medium-bodied** AOP Languedoc wine is complex and terroir-driven. Red fruit flavours, spicy notes and a **bright acidity**.

## E. & F. Jourdan CARIGNAN « Vieilles Vignes » red

Produced from Château l'Argentier's oldest vineyard, 2.25 hectares of Carignan planted in 1935, this 100% Carignan cuvée is well balanced with a long ageing ability.

## E. & F. Jourdan CINSAULT « Vieilles Vignes » red

This 100% Cinsault cuvée is a unique opportunity to discover one of the finest Languedoc indigenous varietal. With soft tannins and a light ruby color this wine is produced from old vines planted in 1969.

## E. & F. Jourdan ARAMON « Vielles Vignes » rosé

This rosé wine is produced from a 3 hectares vineyard of **Aramon planted in 1957**. Produced from another **Languedoc indigenous grape varietal**, this rosé wine shows a light color and **a very good acidity**.
